**AGREEMENT FOR SCIENTIFIC AND  
 EDUCATIONAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN  
 SAMBALPUR UNIVERSITY, INDIA  
 AND**

**THE UNIVERSITY OF GRONINGEN, THE NETHERLANDS**

The Sambalpur University, represented by Sri D.V. Swamy (I.A.S), Vice-Chancellor, and the University of Groningen, represented by Prof. Sibrandes Poppema, President, hereby enter into an agreement for scientific and educational co-operation.

This agreement is to provide for the exchange of staff, scholars, students, academic information and materials in the belief that the research and educational processes at both universities would be enhanced and that mutual understanding between their respective staff, scholars and students would be increased by the establishment of such exchange programmes.

**Article 1**

The universities agree to promote the following exchange programmes, based on their respective academic and educational needs:

1. Exchange of scholars and staff.
2. Exchange of students.
3. Exchange of academic information and materials.
4. Joint research activities and publications.
5. Participation in conferences and academic meetings.
6. Other academic exchanges that both universities agree to.

**Article 2**

The implementation of each exchange programme or joint project based on this agreement shall be separately negotiated and agreed upon in writing by both universities. Any such exchange programme or joint project entered into, as outlined above, will form an appendix to this agreement.

**Article 3**

The projects as mentioned in Article 2, are not intended to be legally binding documents. They are meant to describe the nature and suggest the guidelines of the programme or project. Nothing, therefore, shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor will any constraints be imposed by either upon the other carrying out the agreement.

**Article 4**


Both universities shall designate a programme officer to develop and co-ordinate the specific programmes and projects agreed upon. In case a Programme Officer is not available, the Head (s) of the Departments(s) shall act as Programme Officer for their respective MOU activities.

**Article 5**

This agreement shall become effective from the day it has been signed by both parties and remain valid for an indefinite period, subject to review by both institutions every five (5) years. It is also understood that either institution may terminate the agreement at any time, giving the other not less than 6 months' notice of its wish to terminate, in order to avoid any possible inconvenience to the other institution.
