

2.a Essential educational qualifications: (M.Sc. or equivalent degree/Integrated BS-MS/BS 4 yrs./B.E/B.Tech/B.Pharm/MBBS with at least 55% marks for General(UR)/General-EWS and OBC candidates and 50% for SC/ST and PwD candidates.
