Note:- The matter has been placed in the RAC meeting held on 01.01.2021. The RAC has resolved that "this may be dealt by the COE taking the help of Computer Unit as per the regulation of B.Sc.(Nursing) and the format provided by the Principal Sambalpur Nursing College be approved by the Authority." Since the Academic Council is the final authority for any Changes / Modification in the Regulation, the matter has been placed before the Academic Council for a decision/approval

Complete revised syllabus incorporating the recommended changes has been made available in Appendix E-p-2.

- iii. Minor changes in **P.G. Home Science (Food and Nutrition)** Complete revised

syllabus incorporating the recommended changes has been made available in Appendix E-p-3.

The Board has recommended that the modifications in P.G. Home Science (Human Development and Family Studies) and P.G. Home Science (Food and Nutrition) **may be given retrospective effect from the academic session 2020-21.**

Note: The changes in M.A./M.Sc. Home Science (HDFS) and M.A./M.Sc.(F&N) are related to change in the course structure only. There will be no change in the detailed syllabus in different papers.

- s. **The B.O.S. in Medicine has recommended modifications in the M.B.B.S. regulations as**

Note:- The B.O.S. has not mentioned whether this modification has been recommended for all the Practical Papers or a particular Practical Paper. **Also it is not clear whether this modification contradict the MCI guidelines.** The Academic - I Section has sought a clarification from the Chairperson of the B.O.S. through email.


