The entrance test examination for admission into the three-year Integrated Bed -MED Programme of the Sambalpur University will comprise in Multiple Choice type Question items in the following content areas with number of items and marks as mentioned below against each area.

4	Physical Science Group (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics)	60 [20+20+20]	30	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ From section–B, each candidate has to choose only one subject group as per his UG/+3 stream. ▪ Candidates choosing Physical or Biological Science Group have to answer all items from that subject group only. ▪ Candidate who studied Social Sciences at UG stage has to choose any THREE SUBJECTS ONLY from Social Science Group and answer all questions under those three subjects. ▪ Each correct answer shall be awarded with 0.5 marks.

Question items under teaching aptitude aims at assessing a candidate's basic disposition for teaching as a profession and those under general knowledge are meant to assess a candidate's general awareness as a common citizen of India about the common events and issues of regional and national importance. Questions under English language proficiency shall include items from vocabulary, grammar and comprehension and aim at assessing a candidate's proficiency to study Masters programme in English Medium. Question items under section B in different subject areas shall be of undergraduate level and aims at assessing the mastery of the subject matter in the relevant subject areas. It may be noted that the University reserves the right to fix cutoff scores for each section 'A' and 'B' separately or combinedly as the minimum qualifying marks for preparing the common merit list if it requires so.
