Eligibility: A candidate who has obtained a Master's Degree in the concerned/ allied subject as mentioned in Table -1 from Sambalpur University or any other University/ Institute recognized by Sambalpur University or such degree obtained from a UGC recognized University/ Institution and foreign Universities recognized by Sambalpur University/ AIU/ UGC/ AICTE etc. may be considered equivalent for this purpose by Sambalpur University with at least 55% marks (or equivalent), shall be eligible for admission into the Ph.D. Programme. The respective Nodal Centre should decide on the allied subject. However, candidates belonging to SC/ ST/ Differently-Abled categories and those who obtained their Master's Degree before 19th September 1991 shall be given a relaxation of 5% marks at the Master's Degree level. In-service candidates will have to submit a **No Objection Certificate** from their employers, failing which their application will be rejected. A copy of the same will be submitted at the time of Registration. Candidates who are admitted into the Ph.D. Programme as unemployed candidates and applying for Registration as in-service candidates will have to submit a **No Objection Certificate** from their employers at the time of registration.

The Research Eligibility Test of Sambalpur University (RETSU) will be held on **25.04.2025 (Friday) at 9:00 A.M.** in the University Campus at JyotiVihar. The test will comprise multiple choice questions and shall be of 02 hours in duration.

Reservation of Seats

Reservation of seats under different categories shall be made as per the Odisha State Government norms issued from time to time.

Application Fee:

The candidates willing to take admission shall have to deposit an Application Fee of Rs.2000/- (Rupees two thousand) only through State Bank Collect. (Please refer to details of procedure for depositing the application fee as enclosed herewith).

Exemption from Entrance Test:

Candidates, who have qualified in UGC/ CSIR NET Examination, GATE and such other national level examinations conducted by UGC, ICAR, ICMR, CSIR, ICSSR and other such National Bodies and candidates who are eligible to get a fellowship from national level organizations/ institutions.

Candidates not exempted will have to appear on The Research Eligibility Test of Sambalpur University (RETSU) on **25.04.2025 (FRIDAY) from 9:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M.** and a candidate shall have to secure a minimum of 50% marks in Eligibility Test (relaxation of 5 % of marks for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy layers)/Differently-abled category) in order to be eligible for the Viva-Voce Test at the Nodal Centre for the subject concerned. The list of candidates who have secured at least 50% marks in the RETSU will be displayed in the University website.

Final Selection:

The final merit list of the successful candidates shall be prepared by the Nodal Centre by assigning weightage of 70 marks to the candidate's past academic career and 30 marks to the performance in the Viva-Voce. The assessment of the candidate in the Viva-Voce shall be primarily based on the candidate's subject knowledge, research interest and communication skill. A candidate has to secure at least 15 marks out of 30 (i.e., 50%) to qualify the viva-voce examination.

The decision of the University authority shall be final and binding in the interpretation of application and regulation for Ph.D. Programme of Sambalpur University.
