SAMBALPUR UNIVERSITY: AT A GLANCE

The Sambalpur University Act was passed by the Odisha Legislature on 10th December 1966 to fulfill a long cherished dream of the people of Western Odisha for the establishment of a University. The University started functioning on 1st January 1967, whose territorial jurisdiction covers 10 districts of Odisha. It is spread over a sprawling green campus having 670 acres. The University is accredited with a grade- A by NAAC (third cycle). The University caters to post-graduate education in 32 subjects through 26 post-graduate departments and has been actively engaged in disseminating higher education in the fields of science, technology, humanities, law, and management. The University also runs 09 self-financing programs in emerging areas catering to the needs of the students. The curricular range of the University conforms with the emergent academic needs of the region. Besides the campus at JyotiVihar, Burla, there is a constituent college namely, LR Law College established in 1965. The University also runs another Engineering College named Sambalpur University Institute of Information Technology (SUIIT) which runs Computer Science and Engineering courses.
